## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This is a presentation of the Downtown Fresno Partnership Annual 2020 Report to City Council.

## BACKGROUND

The Downtown Fresno Partnership was established in 2011, and renewed in 2016 for a term of seven (7) years. It is a Property-based Business Improvement District (PBID) that was organized for the improvement of approximately 350 acres in the core of the Downtown area.
