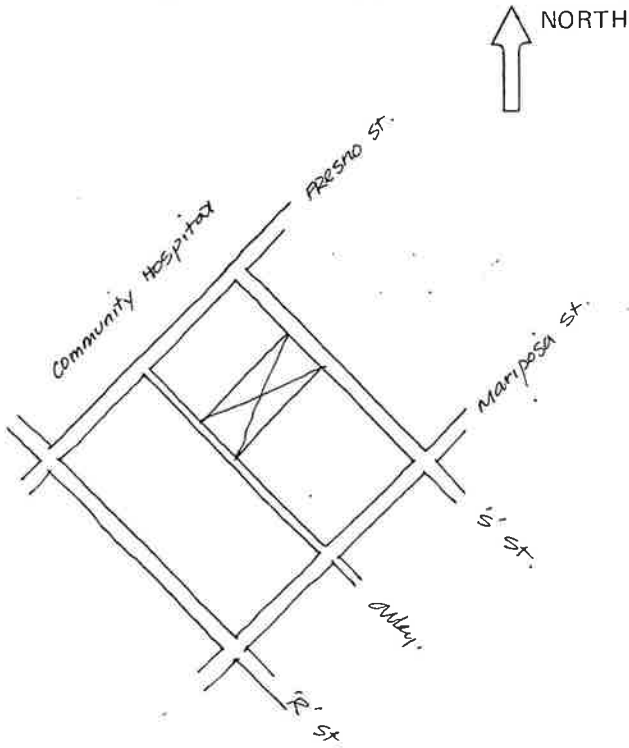

**DESCRIPTION**

6. Briefly describe the present physical appearance of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

Brown shingled building - 2 story with gabled roofs-in the western stick style. Battered columns and walls support the front gabled porch with inset brick decoration in geometric linear design giving relief to the mass. Wide overhangs with exposed beams and knee braces shade the walls which is typical of this style. The building remains inside and outside as it was constructed.

RESOLUTION NO. 80-223

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO DESIGNATING THE ATEN RESIDENCE, LOCATED AT 1133 "S" STREET TO THE LOCAL OFFICIAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC RESOURCES.

WHEREAS, at a noticed public hearing on February 28, 1980, the Historic Preservation Commission heard testimony on the subject property and recommends its designation to the Local Official Register; and

WHEREAS, at a noticed public hearing on April 8, 1980, the Council considered the recommendations of staff, the Historic Preservation Commission and all interested parties; and

WHEREAS, the Aten Residence, located at 1133 "S" Street, was built in 1914; and

WHEREAS, the structure has remained unaltered and in good condition; and

WHEREAS, the structure is one of the few and best remaining examples of the western stick style architecture; and

WHEREAS, the structure is particularly representative of a distinct historical period, style, and way of life; and

WHEREAS, the structure exemplifies the best remaining architectural type of a neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the structure materially benefits the historic character of the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, based upon the presentation of facts relating to the criteria for official designation, the structure has been evaluated and determined to have historic and architectural significance.

WHEREAS, based upon the presentation of facts relating to the criteria for official designation, the structure has been evaluated and determined to have historic and architectural significance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Fresno designates the Aten Residence to the Local Official Register as set forth in Article 4 of Chapter 13 of the Fresno Municipal Code relating to the Preservation of Historic Structures.
